## **GRADE ONE COGITO SUPPLY LIST**

- 8 Plastic duotangs, 1 of each colour: blue, red, yellow, green, orange, clear, purple and 1 extra
- 2 Half and Half interlined scribbler - Hilroy GREEN
- 6 Full page interlined scribbler - Hilroy BLUE
- 1 Hilroy Studio scrapbook 36.6 cm X 27.9 cm
- 36 Blue Staedler-Mars 'Norica' pencils with latex free erasers (NOT from dollarstore)
- 2 Boxes of 24 (not 64 crayons) 'Crayola' (NOT water soluble)
- 2 Packages of 24 pre-sharpened Crayola pencil crayons
- 1 Package of 12 Mr. Sketch markers
- 1 **Prang OVL** – 8 watercolour paints (available at Michael's, Education Station, etc.) No Crayola or Dollar Store
- 6 White erasers-Large
- 1 Bottle of white glue-120 ml
- 7 Large UHU brand gluesticks
- 1 Plastic pencil box (should fit all crayons 'Spacemaker', not extra long)
- 1 Pair of 5 " FISKAR scissors
- 2 Pencil Sharpeners (individual, CLOSED with metal blade. NOT dollarstore)
- 1 Ruler (30 cm only)
- 8 Large Ziploc bags

- 1 Backpack: Please provide a large backpack capable of comfortably fitting a lunch bag, a school agenda, and various learning materials.
- 1 Paintshirt (label with child's name in a zip lock bag please) an old OVERSIZED long sleeved t-shirt is fine
- 1 Black Indoor Running Shoes: Must have non-marking soles to protect gym floors. (NOT platform soles)  
If your child has not yet mastered tying laces, please provide Velcro closures to ensure they can change independently.
- 1 Agenda: School agendas are highly encouraged for classroom consistency and will be available for purchase in September.
